

# Off Licence (For Premises)

Licence No: 15/OFF/1467/2021

## Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Deol Enterprises 2012 Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 973 Heaphy Terrace Fairfield Hamilton 3214 and known as **“Super Liquor (Heaphy Terrace)”**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

**CONDITIONS:** This licence is subject to the following conditions:


- a) **Alcohol may be sold only from 9.00am to 10.00pm, Monday to Sunday.**
- b) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- c) The area where alcohol is to be sold is described in the plan date stamped as received by District Licensing Committee on 9 November 2020.
- d) The entire premises is designated as a supervised area (no persons under 18 can be in the area unless with their parent or legal guardian).
- e) A properly appointed certificated, acting or temporary manager must be on duty and on the premises at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- f) A manager’s register (as required by s.232 of the Act) is to be maintained and available on site.
- g) A Host Responsibility Policy must be maintained and displayed in a prominent place that can be seen by customers and the licensee must ensure all staff receive training in their responsibilities and obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- h) There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be appropriate signs detailing these restrictions at every point of sale.
- i) Drinking water must be freely available and displayed whenever alcohol is being supplied by way of complimentary tastings.
- j) The Licensee must ensure the following are displayed;
  - i) A sign to be seen from outside the principal entrance stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol.
  - ii) A copy of the original licence with all the conditions, just inside the principal entrance so persons entering can read it.
  - iii) A sign in a prominent place identifying the duty manager.
- k) **Remote Sale Conditions**
- k) Alcohol may be sold or supplied remotely at any time, on any day.
- l) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- m) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) is not under the purchase age. The licensee must ensure that the sale will not be made unless the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) completes a declaration that they are 18 years of age or over on first entering the internet site and again immediately before the sale is completed.
- n) The outside of the delivery package must contain the following words:

CONTAINS ALCOHOL

  - Do not leave at destination without proof of delivery.
  - Do not leave with persons under 18 years of age. If the receiver appears to be under the age of 25 years check valid identification such as current passport, driver licence or Hospitality NZ 18+ Card Evidence of Age Document to ensure the receiver is 18 years of age or over.
  - Do not leave with intoxicated persons.
- o) A copy of the licence must be displayed on the Super Liquor Heaphy Terrace internet site in a prominent place.
