

Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

007/OFF/9080/2021

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Jay Ho Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **13-15 Ellis Avenue MOUNT ROSKILL Auckland** and known as **Super Liquor Mt Roskill**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The conditions of the licence are as follows:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 10.00pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (e) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed at each entry, and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (f) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area.
- (g) No sales of:
 - (i) RTDs over 500ml;
 - (ii) Single shots;
 - (iii) Light spirits such as Kristov 62, Mad Jacks Gold Rum and Kentucky Blue Bourbon (being spirits under 14% ABV). For the avoidance of doubt, this does not include low or non-alcoholic spirit products that are not low priced; and
 - (iv) Single RTD products.
- (h) External advertising on the premises is limited to the name/brand of the store. There will be no sandwich boards, flags or similar.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

This licence expires at the close of 14 May 2022 unless renewed.
